Oppose

I am a local resident of Bardon (13 years). I drive through the Cecil rd and Chiswick rd intersection multiple times a day. The traffic congestion in the mornings and afternoons is terrible. Bowman parade feeding into Cecil Rd is also constantly congested at peak times. Adding a child care facility will only add to this congestion. There is no alternate route through to Chiswick Rd from Coopers Camp Rd unless you go up to the McGregor Tce / Jubilee Tce intersection. This is also severely congested every morning. Coopers Camp Rd and Jubilee Terrace are on the traffic reports multiple times per week. There is no way this location can support in a safe and reasonable way the addition of more traffic coming in and out at these peak times. It is a danger to those that live, drive and walk through this area. In addition to the traffic issues, we also question the actual need for another child care facility in Bardon. There have been two new additions in Bardon in the last few years - on Boundary Rd and Coronation St. There are also new centres in Paddington. We strongly oppose this development for these reasons.
